Greetings Purity Church Family,

It is with great joy and thanksgiving to the grace of our Lord Jesus to present Marvin “Trey” Hegar, III to the congregation for nomination as our Pastor. There will be a called Congregational Meeting on Sunday, February 14, 2010 to approve the call and terms of the call. Trey will begin his ministry on Monday, March 1, 2010 and his first Sunday will be on the seventh.

Trey was born and raised in Houston, Texas. Immediately after high school, he served four years in the United States Marine Corps, as an air traffic controller. He then attended Texas State University and studied Literature and Psychology. After graduation, he began work on a Masters of Arts in Literature, but did not finish it because he felt a call to full-time ministry. Consequently, he enrolled in Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Austin, Texas, from which he graduated in 2007 with a Masters of Divinity.



After seminary he was a chaplain resident in Clinical Pastoral Education at Seton Hospital in Austin, Texas for one year. Since August 2008 he has been the Director of Family Ministries at a church in Texas. He has had many opportunities to preach while in this role. He has helped develop family programs, including a youth group. He has assisted in reviewing and implementing curriculum for the education committed. His wife, Sarah, is from Fort Doge, Iowa.

She has graduated from Austin Seminary with a Masters of Divinity. They met and married while both were enrolled in seminary. They have been married for two years.

As a committee, we believe Trey will be able to incorporate the rich traditions, worship, and music of Purity, into a spiritual environment which will not only maintain our faithful but also attract those in our community who presently do not have a church home. We searched for someone with exceptional pulpit skills. We believe we found such skills in this soft-voiced and articulate pastor. His message demonstrates his knowledge of people in today's society, his knowledge of God's Word, love and grace and his ability to use his knowledge to prepare and deliver a sermon addressing the needs and concerns of the people to whom he would minister. Trey has repeatedly demonstrated a willingness to study, research, learn and prepare himself for worship services and the management of God's resources, both human and material.

As a PNC, we know many of you may have questions about Trey, Sarah, his ministry to Purity, and the terms of the call. There will be a question and answer time on Wednesday, February 3, 2010, during the Bible Study hour to address those questions.
